Tents (including those with the odd peg/pole missing) Sleeping bags & Roll mats (wrapped up) Rucksacks (including large camping style) Camping stoves & Camping chairs Wind up torches Matches & Candles Dictionaries (any language) Bibles / The Qu'ran Toothpaste & Toothbrushes Soap & Wet wipes Deoderant Small scissors Towels & Blankets First aid items (plasters, bandages, anti septic wipes, alcohol hand gel, painkillers) Sweeping brooms, Dust pan & Brushes Bin bags Mobile phones and/or chargers Footballs, Basketballs, Tennis balls, Cricket balls Hats & scarves & gloves
